

Trends in malnutrition – South Asia (1995-2009, by quintile)



- <u>Top 10%</u>: appropriated 91% of income gains between 1989-2006
- <u>Top 1%</u>: captured nearly 60% of income-growth between 1976-2007
- <u>Top 0.1%</u>: income share up from 4% to 12% between 1979-2006



Post-2015 framework: 5 steps

- 1. <u>Mid-2012</u>: establish 'Panel of Eminent Persons'
- 2. <u>2012-14</u>: wide consultations & national debates; 6-point agenda
- 3. <u>Early 2015</u>: Panel submits informed options and suggestions
- 4. <u>Late 2015</u>: UN General Assembly adopts new & improved set of global targets
- 5. Late 2015: Establish 'Global Custodian'
