Challenges to existing framework 1

- Who benefits?
- Progress in all indicators in most countries, but...
- Huge inequalities in achievement and some groups being left behind



Challenges to existing framework 2:

- What is progress?
- Dimensions
- Priorities



Political signals toward a consensus 1

- Emerging economies:
- Social policies (cash transfers, universal coverage for services etc)
- Aid policies (growth, infrastructure, exporting own development experience)



Political signals toward a consensus 2

- Traditional donors
- Results
- Growth and private sector
- Change the story



What consensus?

- Universalise to finish the job on the MDGs
- Resilience to create robust societies and a firm basis for progress
- Growth to create the jobs that underpin progress



What framework?

- Targets at 100% or 0
- Incentives for national policies on growth and resilience – league tables, peer review etc

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
