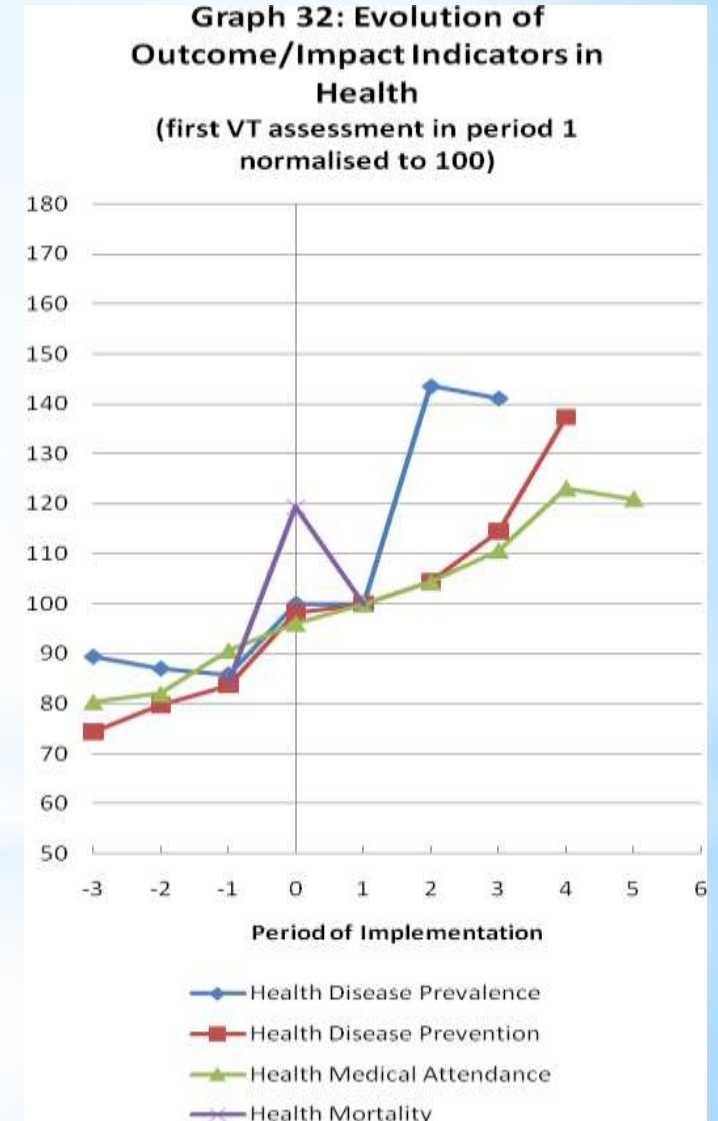
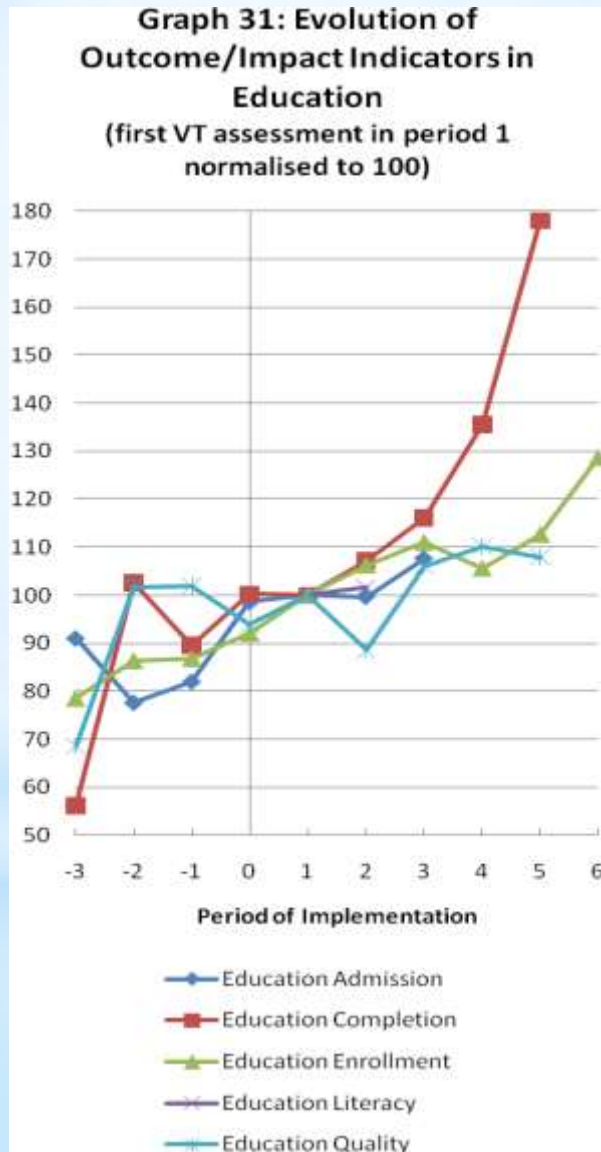

Our Experience

Did result based focus helped to get more results for our aid?

- * -VT up from 35 to 43% (38% after “riders”)
- * -VT indicators down (from average 15 to 12)
- * -VT indicator type and sector shares similar
- * -VT disbursements slightly down (from 71% to 66%)
- * •Mix of indicators: Commission focus on outcomes important, but not as exclusive as perceived
- * •No clear picture regarding differences in performance of different types of indicator
- * •Incentive effects? In medium term -indicator stability is important
- * •Broader assessment of rationale for results not tested

* Context

* **"The Agenda for Change"** (October 2011) the Commission proposes a common results reporting framework.

* **Busan Outcome Document** (December 2011)

Country results frameworks to assess progress of aid.

* **Council Conclusion** on Agenda for Change (May 2012)

Reinforces commitments to common result approaches at EU level.

* Learning

- RBM has been moving "up and down" ..
- Strong push for clear reporting on "operational" results frameworks coming EU Institutions (Parliament, Court of Auditors)
- Experience for Development Banks (WB, AdB) and DfID
- More comfortable with "common approach" rather than "common frameworks"

Staff Working Document

Results Study

Study launched to assist in preparation of result framework. It will include lessons from other donors/ multilateral development banks, outline of EU results framework and assessment of results and indicators used in draft programming documents.

Current Work – Challenges

➤ Agency level

- Programming: stronger accent on result reporting
- System or ad hoc Survey?
- Attribution vs Contribution
- Standardise indicators

➤ Programme Level

- Development of new ROM methodology (Result Based Monitoring , incl. Budget Support).
- Coverage

➤ Country level

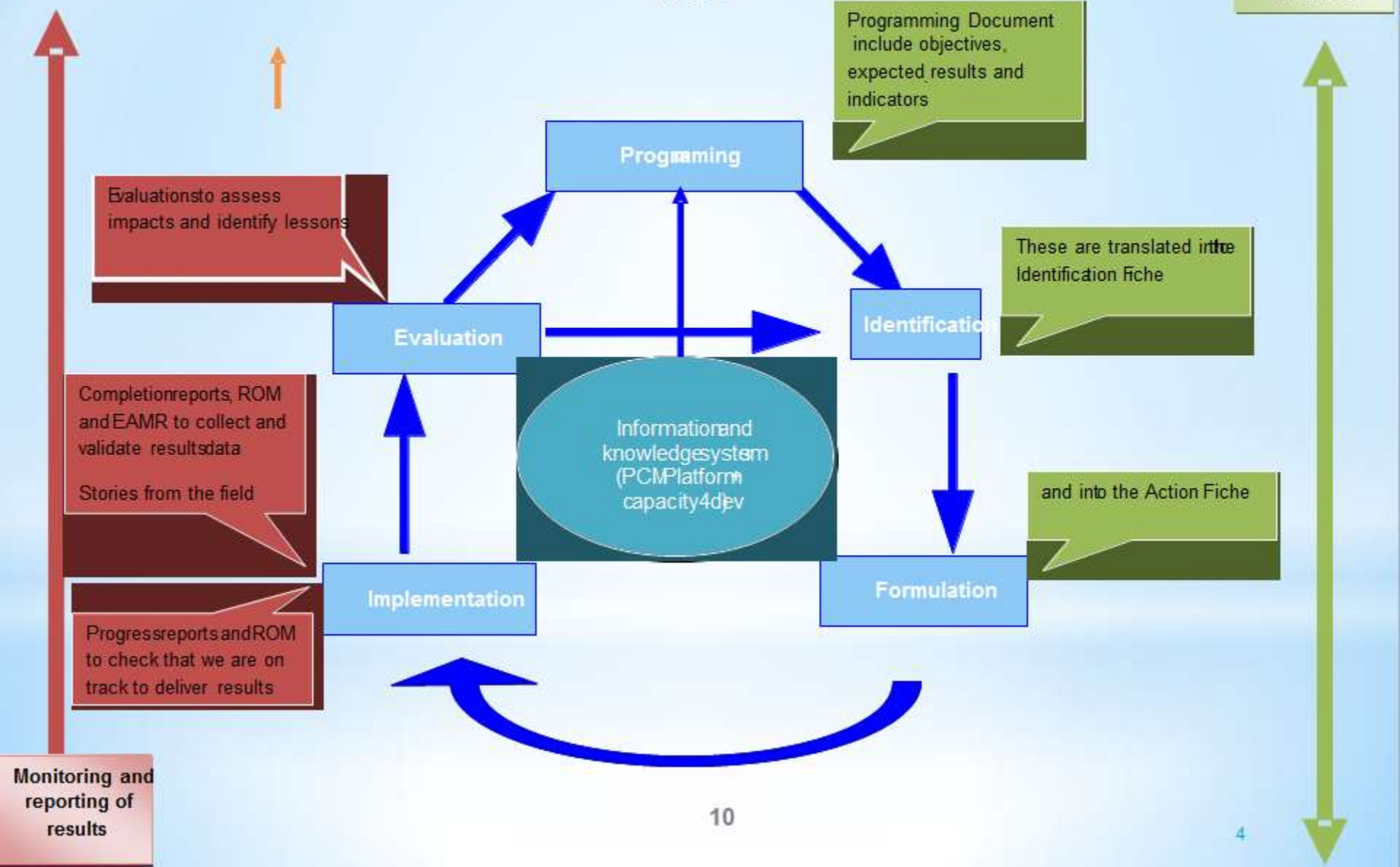
- Post-Busan: country result and accountability agreement
