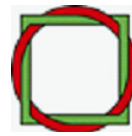

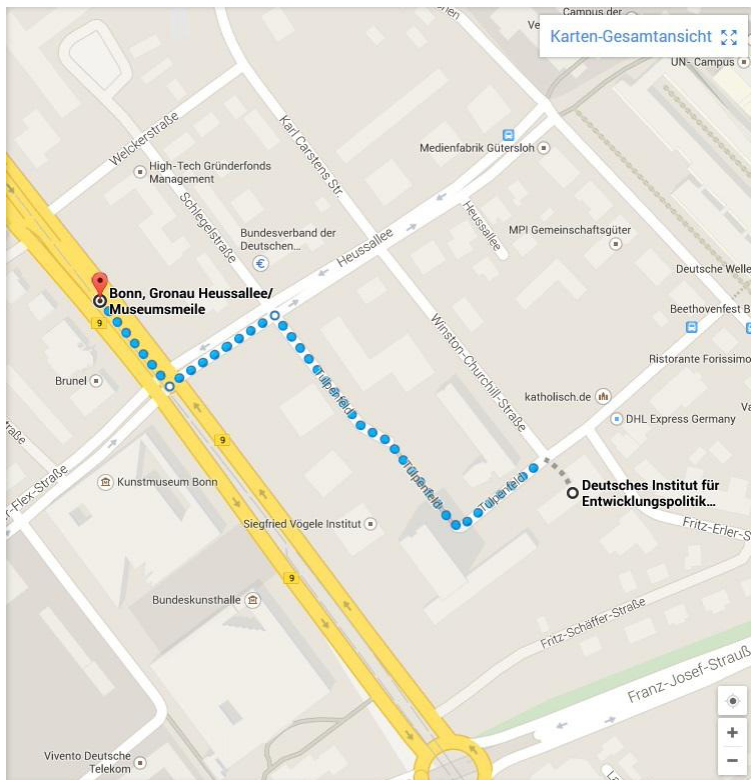

DIRECTIONS

The best way to reach the German Development Institute / Deutsches Institut für Entwicklungspolitik (DIE) is by subway (lines [U16/63](#) or [U66](#)) or by bus (lines [610](#) and [611](#)) from Bonn Central Station (Hauptbahnhof).

- Take the U-Bahn (Subway) U 16 / U 63 or U 66 towards “**Bad Honnef / Bad Godesberg**” and get off at the station “**Heussallee / Museumsmeile**”.
- You may buy your ticket at vending machines either at the Station or on board (choose ticket type 1b; 2.80 Euro, coins only).
- Subway services are available directly to the DIE from **ICE Bahnhof Siegburg/Bonn** using subway line [U66](#) (i.e. stop **Heussallee/Museumsmeile**, about 30 minutes).
- [Cologne/Bonn Airport](#) offers an express bus service ([SB 60](#)). The bus leaves every 20 minutes, please follow the signs at the airport. The ride to Bonn central station (*Hauptbahnhof*) takes about 30 minutes.

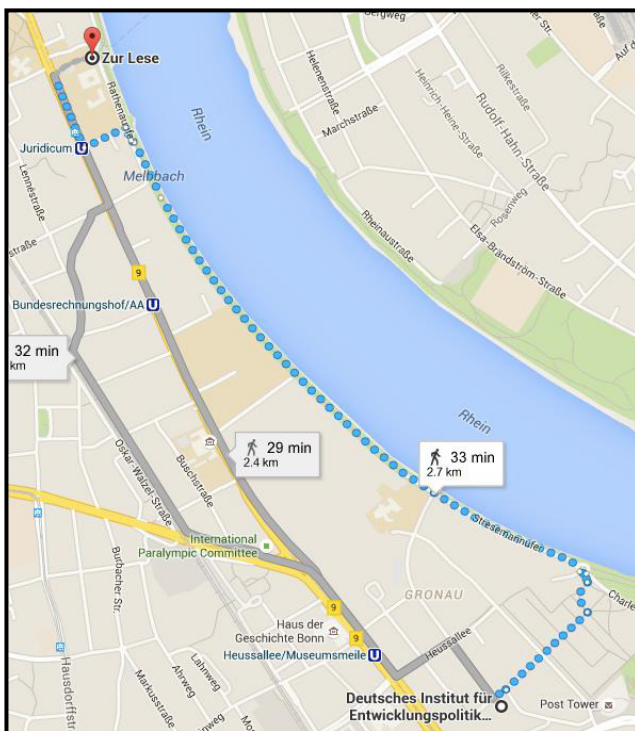


DINNER RECEPTION
